

Taking everything into account, would you say that (OUR COUNTRY) has on balance benefited or not from being a member of the EU? (% - EU)





QF2 Taking everything into account, would you say that (OUR COUNTRY) has on balance benefited or not from being a member of the EU? (% - Benefited)















QG6 What are the main reasons why you decided to vote in the recent European Parliament elections? (MAX. 3 ANSWERS) (% - You are in favour of the EU)










QG6 What are the main reasons why you decided to vote in the recent European Parliament elections? (MAX. 3 ANSWERS) (% - To express your disagreement)











METHODOLOGY

- Coverage: EU28
- Number of interviews: 27,464 respondents
- Population: General population aged 15 or more (post-election questions were filtered on respondents in the age of voting 18+ EU except 16+ in Austria and Malta, 17+ in Greece)
- Methodology: Face-to-Face
- Fieldwork: 07 26 June 2019
- Survey conducted by Kantar, commissioned by the Public Opinion Monitoring Unit, Directorate-General for Communication, European Parliament
